Save the Wye River Pilgrimage, 15-19 August A river pilgrimage to raise awareness and call for action to stop pollution of the river.

An extraordinary voyage is planned for 15th to 19th August. A sculpture of *Our Lady of the Waters and the Wye*, mounted on two canoes made into a canoe-catamaran, will be floated for 75 miles downstream, from Hay-on-Wye to Monmouth. On Thursday 18th the statue will pause at Caradoc Meadow at midday for a picnic lunch and pass under the suspension bridge at Foy at 3pm. Do come and see the river procession.
