Word from RevLaura

The readings I will use Sunday 1st June Acts 16:16-34 and John 17:20-end. What is God saying to you through these scriptures this week.

June is a beautiful month, so much greenery around and the flowers start to blossom. Growing up I had a bookmark that said, 'you can't pluck a rose all fragrant with dew without some of it's fragrance remaining on you'. It is a reminder that God who made the rose also made you and I. God made us on the sixth day, and he saw that what he made was very good (Gen 1) – our God is a God of creation, and his starting place was to see his creation as good, us. As we pray and seek to be in the presence of God may the fragrance of the Holy Spirit remain on us, so that others will know God through us and through our actions. Amen.
