The readings I will use Sunday 8th June Acts 2: 1-21 and John 14: 8-17. What is God saying to you through these scriptures this week. Pentecost is fifty days (in the Jewish calendar) after Passover and is a Jewish Harvest Festival – also celebrating the giving of the Torah (first five books of the Bible). For Christians Pentecost is when the Holy Spirit arrived for us all. Everyone of us can be filled with the power of God and have a new revelation of Jesus. I don't think it is an accident that God chose this celebration to send the Spirit – I think we are reminded here that when we are full of God's power, we are people of the harvest. We can make a difference because we are equipped. I encourage you to pray every day 'Lord fill me with more of your Spirit' so we are active and alive with God's power today.
