**The readings for 13<sup>th</sup> July are Col 1:1-14 and Luke 10:25-37. What is God saying to you through these scriptures this week.**

The words of the baptism service help us to think of our own baptism, maybe you were baptised as a baby, and were confirmed when you were old enough to own the Christian faith for yourself. Or maybe you were baptised as an adult, even full immersed. It is a public declaration that we believe in Jesus, Father and Holy Spirit.
