The readings for 10<sup>th</sup> August are Gal: 4:4-7 and Luke 1:46-55. What is God saying to you through these scriptures this week.

However, it has been quite exciting to watch as the flowers I have planted have grown and flowered. There is satisfaction in knowing you have a part in their life. As I pray here looking out across the benefice it strikes me that I am constantly reminded that we must sow seeds, and nurture that which God is doing in our communities.
